

Completion of “Energy Conservation Training Center” in Vietnam

[Overview of Project]

In order to establish a variety of energy conservation related systems including an energy management system and an energy audit system for management and promotion of energy consumption efficiency of designated business operators, the Vietnamese government enforced the “Act for Energy Conservation and Efficient Utilization of Energy (Energy Conservation Act)” in January 2011. Based on this, the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MOIT), which oversees energy conservation administration in Vietnam, started establishment of a training center for fostering qualified energy managers and energy audit engineers under support of JICA and has now completed it in the suburbs of Ho Chi Minh.
